The 10th Eurasia Rail Exhibition Brought Together the Railway Industry by Hosting 10,603 Visitors from 61 Countries This Year!

The most important issues this year at the International Railway, Light Rail Systems and Logistics Exhibition Eurasia Rail exhibition, which took place at the Istanbul Expo Center (IFM) on 21-23 June 2023, with a total of 10,603 visitors from 61 countries and 212 exhibitors from 17 countries, were Sustainability, Energy, Innovation and Global Collaborations.

Organized by ICA Events, which organizes leading exhibitions in Turkey's leading sectors, the 10th Eurasia Rail hosted 212 local and foreign exhibitors and 10,603 visitors from 17 different countries such as Austria, Canada, China, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Germany, Iran, Italy, Japan, Russian Federation, Spain, Switzerland, Türkiye, USA, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom. The exhibition, which increased the total number of visitors by 38% and the number of international visitors by 174% compared to the previous year, hosted 1,690 international buyers.

Within the scope of the VIP Buyer Delegation program, 203 professional buyers from 34 countries such as Algeria, Azerbaijan, Bulgaria, Canada, China, Colombia, Czechia, Egypt, France, Georgia, Germany, Ghana, India, Italy, Kosovo, Moldova, Nigeria, Portugal, Qatar, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Spain, UAE, UK, Uzbekistan came together with the participants to sign new collaborations.

In the event program, which was held simultaneously with the main support of the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure, TCDD and TCDD Transportation, the topics of Sustainability, Energy, Innovation, Global Collaborations were discussed during the three-day exhibition. 50 expert speakers and more than 2000 industry professionals were hosted with the cooperation of industry-leading institutions, organizations and associations such as METRO ISTANBUL, IMM, ERCİYAS, ASELSAN, DİTECFER, TÜBİTAK RUTE, EU-Rail, ARUS and RSD. At Eurasia Rail, where the latest developments on the world-famous Hyperloop Technology were conveyed, start-ups that made their mark on the sector with augmented reality, autonomous robots, cyber security, 3D printing, simulation technologies, BIM and energy efficiency solutions also came together with the leaders of the sector.

In the session moderated by Erciyas Holding CEO K. Emre Erciyas, which was held as part of the first day program of Eurasia Rail, Hyperloop TT CEO Andrés de Leon shared his knowledge about Hyperloop technology and gave hopeful messages in the course of development of this technology. On the 2nd day of Eurasia Rail, the topics of "Hyperloop Project Connecting Continents in Minutes" and "Collaborations in the Scope of Research and Innovation in Railways" were discussed with valuable participants and speakers. In his speech titled Transport Vision of the Century of Türkiye, held within the scope of sectoral sessions, AKP Trabzon Deputy, Chairman of the Grand National Assembly of Türkiye Public Works, Zoning, Transport and Tourism Commission, Turkish Republic 66th Minister of Transport and



Infrastructure Adil Karaismailođlu talked about the investments they made and the future projects of Türkiye.

International Railway, Light Rail Systems and Logistics Exhibition - Eurasia Rail, which is Türkiye's only and the world's third largest railway and light rail systems exhibition, which features the most used products of the public and private sectors, will not only enable existing relations and cooperation, but also provide opportunities for existing relations and collaborations. also hosted new export opportunities in the Turkish railway industry.
