Countdown for Eurasia Rail Exhibition Has Begun!

The International Railway, Light Rail Systems, Infrastructure and Logistics Exhibition, Eurasia Rail, is counting down the days to welcome leading names and visitors from the railway industry at Istanbul Expo Center from June 18 to 20, 2025.

Eurasia Rail, Türkiye's only and the world's 3rd largest railway and light rail systems exhibition, starts on June 18th at Istanbul Expo Center. The exhibition has not only taken the pulse of the sector in Eurasia since 2011 but also will bring together the world's leading railway authorities for the 11th time, improving existing relations and paving the way for new cooperations.

Eurasia Rail Exhibition Will Once Again Be The Meeting Point Of The Railway Industry

This year, the 11th edition of Eurasia Rail, Türkiye's premier gathering for the railway industry, will host exhibitors from Austria, Canada, China, the Czech Republic, France, Germany, India, Iran, Italy, Kazakhstan, Spain, Switzerland, Türkiye, the United Kingdom, and the United States.

As part of the VIP Hosted Buyer Program, 150 exhibitors from over 40 countries, including Spain, France, the United States, Russia, Saudi Arabia, the Czech Republic, India, and Italy, will be hosted, offering companies the opportunity to expand their business volumes, as in previous years. In addition, numerous leading domestic and international industry players such as TCDD, Talgo, Knorr-Bremse, Siemens, Pandrol, Aselsan, Greenbrier, and Hitachi will take part in the exhibition.

Eurasia Rail Exhibition Director Semi Benbanaste emphasized that the exhibition stands out as the most direct gateway into the highly lucrative railway sector, stating: *"Rail systems around the world are gaining increasing importance each day, as they offer fast, economical, environmentally friendly, safe, and modern transportation solutions. Türkiye is also making significant strides in this field, accelerating its railway investments. Extensive investments are accelerating modernization efforts, strengthening logistics networks, and enhancing global competitiveness. These developments further strengthen Türkiye's influence and growth potential in the global rail market. In the coming years, further enhancement is targeted with sustainable transportation and infrastructure projects."*

Semi Benbanaste continued his remarks as follows: *"At Eurasia Rail, the only rail systems exhibition in the Eurasia region, we are preparing to share our country's success story in this field with the entire world. The bilateral business meetings held within the scope of Eurasia Rail will significantly contribute*



to both the railway sector and the national economy. Additionally, the conference sessions, scheduled alongside the exhibition, will provide a vital platform for sharing industry knowledge and expertise. As we prepare to host Eurasia Rail for the 11th time, we are fully committed to experiencing firsthand the sector's great transformation and introducing visitors to the latest innovations in railway technologies."

Industry Development and Innovative Solutions to Be Explored at Eurasia Rail

This year, Eurasia Rail will feature a three-day activity program during the exhibition. The program will include sessions focused on collaborations within the sector, international agreements, new-generation systems and technologies in transportation as well as success stories, and marketing strategies.

Shaping the future of the railway sector, the exhibition will be structured around three key thematic pillars. The **"Investments and Growth"** pillar will address strategies for global expansion, market entry, and financing opportunities. Meanwhile, the **"Investments, Export and Logistics"** pillar will address investment strategies and the financial sustainability of the sector.

In the **"Connections and Cooperation"** focus, discussions will center on mega projects such as **"Transport Vision,"** global partnerships, the Middle Corridor and Development Road initiatives. Experts will explore how railway networks across different regions can be integrated, how logistics processes can be optimized, and how international cooperation can be strengthened.

From the **"Sustainability and Environment"** perspective, key topics will include reducing the environmental impact of rail transportation, incorporating renewable energy sources, implementing intelligent transportation systems, and utilizing sustainable materials. Under **"Transportation for Climate,"** discussions will focus on solutions to safeguard the sector from environmental challenges.

Finally, **"The Future of Mobility"** will address the role of artificial intelligence, user experience, and industry transformation with an exchange of ideas on how transportation systems will evolve in the future.
