

Eurasia Rail, the only gathering of the railway industry in Türkiye, will open its doors at Istanbul Expo Center

The International Rolling Stock, Infrastructure and Logistics Exhibition - Eurasia Rail, organized by ICA Events in cooperation with the Republic of Türkiye Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure and the Republic of Türkiye State Railways since 2011, will open its doors from 24–26 March 2027. Hosting 11,783 visitors from 71 countries and generating a business volume of €250 million at its previous edition held in 2025, the exhibition will bring the railway industry together once again, creating added value for transportation and the economy.

As the only gathering of the rail systems industry in the Eurasia region and one of the most prestigious meeting points of the global railway industry, Eurasia Rail will bring the industry together for the 12th time from 24–26 March 2027, organized by ICA Events in cooperation with the Republic of Türkiye Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure and the Republic of Türkiye State Railways. In addition to keeping its finger on the pulse of the industry in the Eurasia region, the exhibition also provides opportunities for existing relationships and new collaborations, bringing together leading railway authorities from around the world for three days at Istanbul Expo Center. At the exhibition, which shapes the future of rail systems, the latest developments in railway transportation will be addressed in detail for both exhibitors and visitors, while expert opinions will be shared through conferences and seminars, providing the industry with the most up-to-date information.

Stating that Eurasia Rail creates strong added value for the industry by bringing the public and private sectors together, Semi Benbanaste, Director of the International Rolling Stock, Infrastructure and Logistics Exhibition - Eurasia Rail, said: "Eurasia Rail, which we organize to contribute to Türkiye achieving a stronger position in the global railway industry, has made a significant contribution to the national economy since its first edition. We can see the most concrete outcome of this through the figures from our previous edition. At our 2025 exhibition, we hosted a total of 11,783 visitors, including 1,346 international visitors, and 213 exhibitors from 17 countries. While the business volume generated by exhibitors reached €250 million, this created €1 million in new business per exhibitor. In addition, a total of 1,093 orders and preliminary agreements were signed, while more than 3,000 B2B meetings were held. At our previous exhibition, we also implemented the Eurasia Rail 2025 Conference Program to share a comprehensive vision with the industry, ranging from the future of physical infrastructure and digital transformation to sustainable mobility and international collaborations. At our 2027 gathering, we will once again address the transformation of the railway industry in all its dimensions, from infrastructure to digitalization and from local to international, through events and innovations."
